Karaoke Contest Details

- Qualifying held Friday, June 27 & Saturday, June 28, starting 9:30 p.m. each night.
- Maximum 30 contestants each night.
- 6 contestants, the top 3 contestants from each night's qualifying, will advance to the final round, held Saturday night immediately after the 2nd night qualifying.
- Scoring will be based on the following scores:
 - 50 Points Vocal Ability
 - 25 Points Song Knowledge & Timing
 - 15 Points Stage Presence & Appearance
 - 10 Points Audience Reaction
 - 100 Points Total Possible Score

Prizes

- 1st place \$200, 2nd place \$100, 3rd place \$75, 4th place \$50, 5th place \$35, 6th place \$20

Contest Signup

- Signup for Karaoke contest at Fair office, week of Fair. Signup will close at 5:00 p.m. Friday June 27.
- Maximum of 30 contestants for each qualifying night.
- Contestant is to choose which night he/she will participate in qualifying. A person can only make one qualifying attempt.
- Order of contestants in contest will be selected by random drawing, and the singing order will be posted in the Expo Pavilion.
- Contestants must be 21 years of age at the time of the contest.
- Only amateur singers will be allowed to enter. (NO karaoke hosts, or professional singers will be allowed to enter.)

Competition Rules

- Check-in for contestants will start at 9:00 p.m. each night in the Expo Pavilion.
- Contestants will be presented a number at check-in to show place in the lineup.
- All performances are limited to 4 minutes. The music will be faded out after that time.
- Due to time and space restrictions, live instruments will not be allowed at the event.
- All aspects of the act, including, but not limited to: costume, conduct on stage, and song lyrics, are to abide by no worse than a "PG-13" standard.
- No flash effects, fake blood, spewing liquids, etc.
- Costumes are encouraged, but must be in good taste, and void of vulgar and offensive themes.
- All songs must be a part of KJ Productions song list.
- The Mighty Howard County Fair and/or KJ Productions reserves the right to keep any individual from performing for any reason or terminate the act in mid-song.
- Judges will be chosen by the Mighty Howard County Fair.
